KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the duly elected, qualified and acting President and Secretary of the **BASQUE CLUB**, an unincorporated association, duly authorized by such association to execute these Articles of Incorporation on behalf of such association in witness of the fact that the members of said association do hereby voluntarily associate themselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California, and do hereby certify:

FIRST

That the name of the corporation shall be: **BASQUE CLUB.**

SECOND

That the purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

1.) The specific and primary purpose of the corporation is to unite for their welfare all people of the Basque Region of France and Spain, by birth or descent, and to promote their social, recreational, intellectual, physical and moral welfare.

THIRD

Other activities and general purposes or powers for which this corporation is formed are:

- 1.) To acquire in the corporation's name, hold, hypothecate, improve, maintain and transfer real and personal property in the furtherance of the activities of the corporation.
- 2.) To receive contributions in money or other property and to borrow money or other property to be used or expended for the purposes and activities of the corporation and for other expenses or needs of the corporation.
- 3.) To levy dues or assessments against memberships in this corporation as needed or required for the purposes of the corporation.
- 4.) To do any and all things herein set forth, and, in addition, such other acts and things as are necessary, convenient or proper for, or incidental to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation, or any of them.

FOURTH

That the corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California, (Part I of Division 2 of

FIFTH

That the County in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is located is the City and County of San Francisco.

SIXTH

That the number of Directors shall be twelve (12).

That by the execution of this instrument and compliance with the Laws of California relative hereto an existing unincorporated association known as "BASQUE CLUB" is being incorporated.
